

AQVESME™ Risk Evaluation and Mitigation Strategy (REMS)

Enrollment Overview



AQVESME is only available through AQVESME REMS, a program designed to inform you of the potential risk of liver injury and to monitor your liver function. REMS are required by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for certain medicines to help manage the risk of serious side effects.

3 key actions to help start treatment promptly

Once you and your doctor have reviewed AQVESME clinical and REMS information and decided AQVESME is right for you, these are the steps to start treatment promptly:

1 You and your doctor complete and sign the AQVESME Start Form and your doctor completes AQVESME REMS certification

The AQVESME Start Form enrolls you in myAgiOS® Patient Support Services. The myAgiOS team can assist you and your doctor in determining insurance coverage and exploring financial assistance options.

For your convenience, you may get started with enrollment in AQVESME REMS by reviewing, signing, and dating the AQVESME REMS Patient Enrollment Form at the same time as the AQVESME Start Form either in person or electronically.

2 Complete liver test

A blood test to show how well your liver is working **MUST be completed within 4 weeks of the first prescription being filled**. The myAgiOS team will work with you and your doctor to determine the ideal timing for the required liver test based on the status of insurance determination.

Since prior authorization may take time to process, it is recommended that prior authorization be approved before performing the liver test.

3 Your doctor enrolls you in AQVESME REMS

If you haven't done so already, you and your doctor must complete and sign the AQVESME REMS Patient Enrollment Form either in person or electronically. Your doctor will need to include the date of the pre-treatment liver test as part of this form.

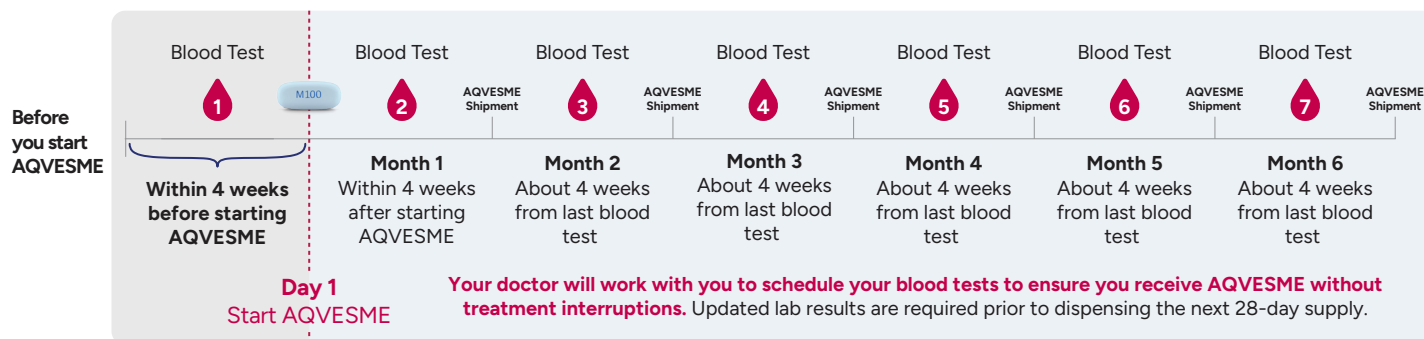

Your first 24 weeks taking AQVESME: Liver monitoring

- Complete a blood test to check your liver every 4 weeks for the first 24 weeks while taking AQVESME
- Your prescription will be authorized only after each liver test is completed for the first 24 weeks
